

CITY OF LONG GROVE  
COUNCIL MEETING  
MINUTES  
March 8, 2011

Mayor Weibel called the Long Grove City Council Meeting to order at 7:00 PM at City Hall.

Roll Call: Present: Schmidt, Davis, Hambly, Thiessen and Abington

Absent: None

The agenda was approved as presented on a motion by Davis and seconded by Schmidt, all ayes, motion carries.

Consent agenda approved as written on a motion by Abington and second by Davis, all ayes motion carries.

Mayor Weibel opened the Public Hearing for the Proposed Budget FY12. Asking for public comment, there was none. Mayor Weibel closed the Public Hearing.

Hambly made a motion to accept Resolution #2011-02 approving the proposed Budget FY12 as published and presented for Public Hearing for the 2012 Fiscal year. Abington seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carries.

**Old Business**

Drainage on the easement at the Riewerts property was moved to the Sewer and Water Committee on a motion by Schmidt to hold a meeting before the next regular Council meeting and second by Hambly. All ayes, motion carries.

Kirby White reported that the Elizabeth White Memorial is ready for installation. A Memorial service will be planned at a later date.

The Mayor reported on an email received from North Scott Soccer Club proposing a soccer complex. At this time the city has no land available for the purpose. The City Clerk will notify the club.

Schmidt, Chair of the Sewer and Water Committee gave the Council the Committees recommendation for the proposed well sites. The Council approved Jon White, City Engineer to proceed with the application to the DNR to evaluate three sites and report their findings on a motion by Schmidt and second by Abington. All ayes, motion carries.

Schmidt reported that White recommended the City separate the sludge removal and the reshaping of the lagoon as two phases of the project for bidding. Schmidt made a motion for White to proceed with the preparation of bids for sludge removal. Thiessen seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carries.

### **New Business**

Schmidt made a motion to transfer funds from Debt Service fund to the General Fund and Sewer Fund which were borrowed for the first year payments on the General Obligation Bond. Second by Thiessen, all ayes, motion carries.

Hambly made a motion for Scott County Lawns to do a Spring and Fall spray at the City parks and limited green space. Davis seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carries.

Hambly made a motion to add the name of Ida Weibel to signature cards at First Central State Bank and Valley State Bank. Thiessen seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carries.

Allied Waste has requested to start waste and recycling pick up at 7:00AM, instead of 8:00AM. On a motion by Schmidt to grant permission to Allied Waste to start pick up at 7:00AM on May 5, 2011, allowing time for the City to notify all residents. The motion carried with a second by Hambly and all ayes.

Thiessen made a motion to honor the budgeted amount of \$2,870 as a donation to the Long Grove Civic League. On a second by Schmidt and all ayes the motion carries.

Deputy Clerk Terry Gentz reported she is working on several different grants with applications being accepted in April and October. On a motion by Davis and second by Abington Gentz may proceed with the application. All ayes, motion carries. The Council approved for Gentz to attend a Grants Workshop on a motion by Thiessen and second by Schmidt, all ayes, motion carries.

Mayor's report- Mayor Weibel recommended Council members to review the revised Bike Path plans. She also reported she would be attending the North Scott Superintendent's meeting with the Mayors of the North Scott District and asked Council if they had any input, to contact her.

Public Comment-A citizen asked if Long Grove had applied for the grant money offered by Scott County Waste Commission. The Clerk reported that the information had not been received from the Commission yet. The citizen reported that Blue Grass and Eldridge have already implemented their grant. The City Clerk will look into it. Also questioned was a certificate reaching maturity. The citizen was informed it would be renewed at a local institution.

Abington made a motion for adjournment, with a second by Hambly, all ayes, motion carries.
