

City of Long Grove
Council Meeting
February 9, 2012

The Long Grove City Council held a Special Council Meeting on February 9, 2012. This meeting included a Public Hearing on the rezoning of the Ellen Bernice Wulf Revocable Trust property. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm in City Hall. Abington made a motion to move the meeting to the Long Grove Community Center, due to the amount of persons in attendance. The motion was seconded by Schmidt, all ayes motion carries. The meeting reconvened at the Long Grove Community Center.

Present: Abington, Dalton, Thiessen, Davis and Schmidt.

The agenda was approved on a motion by Dalton, a second from Abington, all ayes, motion carries.

Before opening the Public Hearing Mayor Weibel gave the rules and procedures of conducting the Public Hearing.

Mayor Weibel opened the Public Hearing and asked for the applicants of the rezoning to state their request. William McCullough, attorney for the applicants stated the request for the property to be rezoned to C-4 Highway/Intensive Commercial, followed by Pat Siemsen, applicant.

The Mayor informed guests there would be a two minute time limit on comments and names would be called from the sign in list. Proponents and objectors were given equal time to comment.

After those in attendance were given opportunity to speak the Mayor closed the Public Hearing.

Council had discussion as to procedure to follow and a motion was made by Schmidt and seconded by Davis to approve the first reading of the rezoning ordinance for the Ellen Bernice Wulf Revocable Trust property and to set a Special Meeting for February 21, 2012 at City Hall for the second reading. Roll call vote was taken: Ayes: Abington, Dalton, Schmidt, Davis, Thiessen. Nays: None. Motion carries for approval of the first reading for rezoning.

A motion to adjourn was made by Schmidt and seconded by Dalton, all ayes motion carries.
